Sheffield Place Launches Expansion Initiative

Sheffield Place Continues to Grow to Serve More Families

To serve more families with more intensive services, Sheffield Place will build an additional building nearby to house 5 additional families, provide a classroom to be used for aftercare/outpatient programming, case management and substance abuse counseling offices.

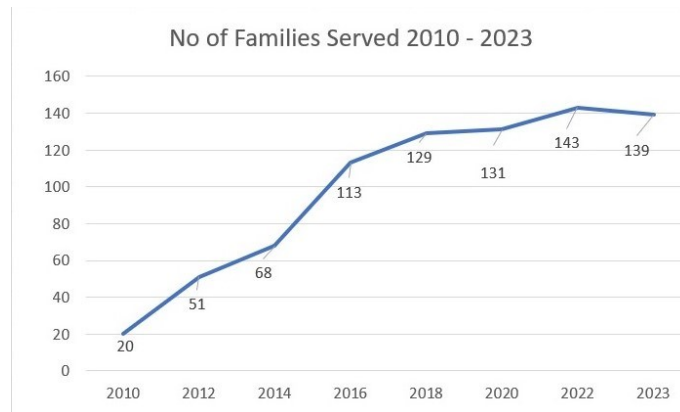
The agency has purchased land two blocks away for the new building. Project construction is scheduled to begin this fall with a late 2025 completion date.



Demand for Services Far Exceeds Capacity

Sheffield Place received 924 calls in 2023 from mothers seeking services. The agency was able to admit just 109 of those families into the residential services program or 12 percent of the demand. The call volume represents a substantial increase from the 505 calls the agency received as recently as 2012.

PROGRAM OUTCOMES - 2023

Residential Housing Services	61% of mothers who stayed 30 days or longer exited to permanent housing; 51% for all discharges.	The average length of stay was 4.5 months for families that stayed 30 days or longer; 2.9 months for all discharges.	44% of mothers who stayed 30 days or longer improved income; 28% for all discharges.
Residential Clinical Services— Children	30.4% of children (6 through 18 years) increased or maintained mental health functioning	The average age of the children in the residential program was 5.5 years; the average age of the mothers was 32 years.	74% of mothers improved parenting
Residential Clinical Services — Adults	68% of mothers improved mental health functioning	83% of mothers who stayed 30 days or more were clean and sober at discharge; 65% for all discharges	100% engaged in work development activities: job search group, job search coaching, and substance abuse treatment among others.
Aftercare Services	87% of families maintained permanent housing		72% of families increased or maintained income

CAITLIN'S STORY

Sheffield Place empowers families like Caitlin to make the difficult journey from homelessness to self-sufficiency. Here is her story:

I started experimenting with drugs at age nine and found meth by 14 and soon began using drugs daily. I dropped out of high school.

Now, at the age of 39, I have been to prison five times for multiple drug felonies – paying with over six and a half years of my life.

Since being at Sheffield Place, I've had the same job for 10 months recently receiving a promotion. I live in a Sheffield house and have paid off my past utilities.



I have my 19-month-old daughter who came home from foster care and my 13-year-old son is back with me full-time. I was an absent mother of my 6 children but am now involved in all of their lives.

I am active in Narcotics Anonymous and attend my home group anywhere from 3-7 times a week. I will be off probation in May. I am excited to see what's next in our lives. I am grateful for each day.
